

## Mentor Role Description

### Definition:

A mentor is someone with a little more life experience who comes alongside another and points her to Jesus.

### Requirements:

- Devoted to growing in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Committed to reading, studying, and applying the Word of God and living in obedience
- Committed to prayer- personally and with others
- Consistently attend Fellowship Bible Church and agree with their statement of faith.
- Dedicated to follow through on commitment to this ministry

### Expectations

- Attend mentoring meetings and events for the purpose of
  - Equipping and training you as a mentor
  - Answering any questions; addressing concerns
  - Uniting in prayer with others
- Respect the leadership of mentoring team and church leadership
- If married, have your husband’s support of your participation in this ministry
- Meet with your mentee regularly- establish a mutually determined schedule/frequency for meeting together
- Remain FAT- Faithful, Available, Teachable
- Be authentic and real with each other
- Keep confidentiality a priority
- Recognize that you don’t have to be perfect or have all the answers
- Consistently pray with and for your mentee and discuss communication preferences
- Pray for multiplication- mentees becoming mentors.
